### **Contest Description:**

COSS has been organizing large-scale racing events since 2002. From 2002-2005 we organized a large race in Breckenridge. In 2006 we moved the race to the frontrange city of Longmont. The 2007 US Nationals will consist of 3 dual-lane events, one in each of the disciplines: GS, HS, and TS. The Cities of Longmont and Windsor are fully supportive of this annual event.

### ***Dual Giant Slalom:***

Friday 8/24 (8AM -4PM), Windsor, CO – Dual Giant Slalom. Competitors will each have 2 qualifying runs. No special races for Women, Jrs, or Kids divisions. After qualifying, Top 16 in Pro and Top 32 in Open will advance to dual eliminations. Same venue as in 2006, approximately 1000' course containing 30+ cones.

### ***Dual Hybrid Slalom:***

Saturday 8/25 (8AM - 6PM), Longmont, CO – Dual Giant Slalom. Competitors will each have 2 qualifying runs. After qualifying, Top 16 in Pro and Top 32 in Open will advance to dual eliminations. Special events for Women, Jrs, and Kids. You must choose one and only one class to race in. Same venue as in 2006, approximately 600' course containing 50+ cones.

### ***Dual Tight Slalom:***

Sunday 8/25 (8AM - 6PM), Longmont, CO – Dual Tight Slalom. Competitors will each have 2 qualifying runs. After qualifying, Top 16 in Pro and Top 32 in Open will advance to dual eliminations. Special events for Women, Jrs, and Kids. You must choose one and only one class to race in. Venue may be same as in 2006 or a similar hill, approximately 600' course containing 70+ cones.
