

ISSA Prime Status Sanction Approval Confirmation - 2023 Season - North America

On behalf of the North American status marshals, I am pleased to let you know your ISSA sanction application for Prime status (copy attached) has been approved. To ensure things go as smooth as possible, please note a few important guidelines and requirements:

Sanction Fee - Due Now: Please submit your sanction fee in the amount of \$60 to the ISSA via paypal using this link: <https://www.paypal.me/ISSAslalom/60usd>

This fee must be paid/received in order for your sanction status to become effective and ensure racers receive their proper ranking points. The sanction fee payment also covers ISSA membership for each racing participant at the event and ensures membership privileges such as voting rights as well as inclusion in the world ranking database.

Calendar Listing - Please do immediately: Register your event on the race calendar with the on-line registration.

- **Log in on www-slalomranking.com** and you will be forwarded to your personal ranking home page. You need to be logged in at the ranking site to use it. If you don't have your forum user linked to the ranking pages contact Corky ranking@slalomskateboarder.com to ask for that.

- Click button "Settings". On your personal ranking home page.
- Click button "Add event".
- Select and fill in basic event info on fields in the order they come up.
Note the little information icon on the different sections. Click on it to get more information. If you still are missing some information let us know in this forum and we will add it.
- Post the "event registration" at the end.
ISSA administrators we will have a look at it before we publish it.
But the event page does exist, it's only that we don't show it in the calendar. It may be that you as organizer want to add some additional information before making the event public in the calendar.
For example: Adding more information/articles/pictures. Adding more organizers. Adding some links to forum, facebook, ... Adding a poster. Adding map coordinates for a new spot (or an old spot with missing coordinates).

Event Promo: You may include the ISSA logo on your flyers, promo, etc. - download current version: http://www.slalomskateboarder.com/ISSA/Logo/ISSA_logo_2017.pdf Please supply links to your event listings (website, social media event pages, etc) and forward any event poster you have. If you can provide a graphic format sized 1000 pixels square for use on social media - that would be ideal. Please also post/share notices/updates on the ISSA group facebook page about your event leading up to the race. <https://www.facebook.com/groups/50928427525> (Hashtags: #WorldSkateSB #WorldSkateSlalom #USASlalomSkateboarding #USASkateboarding #ISSASlalomSB)

Pro Ranking Minimum: Keep in mind on race day especially, you may want/need to move an AM or two up into the Pro division to avoid falling below eight Pros at this Prime status race. The ranking system will NOT give full Pro points unless there are at least eight Pros actually racing.

Event Results: Posting results at the end of each day would be ideal and the overall goal is to have full results (and spreadsheets if possible) posted within 24 hours on the ISSA facebook group page after the event. Photos and/or videos are also great to have. OK to post on your event page (or website) and then share to the ISSA facebook page. Results must also be submitted via email to Hans "Corky" Koraeus at: ranking@slalomskateboarder.com so they can be incorporated into the ISSA ranking system. Please cc that email to the status marshals (above) so we can lend a hand if needed with post-event reporting.

Event Insurance: If you need assistance with obtaining insurance for your event - please contact Lynn Kramer at: 619-246-3371 - to discuss options as soon as possible.
