Contest Description: The Texas Cold Fusion Sizzler has been the $1^{\text {st }}$ major event for the passes 5 years, since it moved to Austin Texas. In 2011 we moved the race to the Houston area to take advantage of the new soap box derby hill. With a close as perfect surface and pitch the hill is well suited to all form of racing. We have popular support for locals as well as the slalom community. We have a wide range of events and enjoy a lot of crossover from people other disciplines because if it.

## Race Event \#1 description:

\#1: Slalom cross will be done on a draw from the hat method using winners and losers brackets, loose once you're out. We have changed it to single elimination because we are running this even on Friday night and it is the only way we can fit it in. we will use a flip of the coin to pick your lane. Slalom Cross will have no classes.
This will be done on a course as large and wide open the hill will allow so there will be a 3 cone DQ limit. The slalom cross will be using Ricky Byrd style start ramps.
\#2: Giant Slalom will be single lane jam style A Class B \& C class will be chosen by the timer. Racers may go off the big ramp the small ramp or no ramp. There will be one lower start that may be chosen by the racer but a 30 second penalty will be added to their time Cone penalty .10 per cone 10 cone DQ limit, all racers get two runs.
\#3: Hybrid slalom will be $1^{\text {st }}$ qualifying and then head to head racing. Cone penalty. 10 per cone 10 cone DQ limit; we will be using Ricky Byrd style start ramps and Trakmate timer with false start detection. If you false start that will be doubled and added to you time.
\#4: Tight slalom will run $1^{\text {st }}$ A class from the top with Ricky Byrd Style start ramps a class will be the top 16 only. Qualifying then head to head ladder style racing. Note if you do not qualify for the A class then the racer will be allowed to race in the $B / C$ race. But their times will be reset.

B\& C class will run down farther on the hill, it will be run single lane jam style; all racers will get two runs. Note there will be two lanes form the a class race already set up, so we will both lanes but still it will be run jam style.
