Contest Description:

The contest will be held in Nevada City on the hill used for their annual Soapbox Derby

Age groups as described in ISSA rules:

MASTERS: 45 and up

OPEN: 17 and up WOMEN: All ages

JUNIORS: 17 and under (racers whose age will not reach 18 in the current calendar year)

Race Event #1 Giant Slalom:

Approx 2000' long with approx. 40-50 cones

Surface: medium grade asphalt

Choice of 8' start ramp or 4' start ramp

Race Event #2 Super Giant Slalom:

Approx 2000' long with approx. 30-40 cones

Surface: medium grade asphalt

Choice of 8' start ramp or 4' start ramp

Push starts will be permitted from the back edge of the ramp.
