One venue confirmed for two days suitable for Hybrid and TS used previously for Canadian Nationals in 2014. Working on alternative venues and are scouting other potential sites for the Giant Slalom. We will use our past insurer if we do not find a community partner.		
Prizes and value of prizes to be awarded:		
A minimum cash purse of \$2,500 will be awarded. Sponsorship and entry fees will determine the final amount. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three professional racers plus an overall amount for Top 3. The women's top three overall winners will also receive a cash prize. If the amounts are substantial we will either pay to 5 th or 8 th in the Pro men's and/or pay for the overall rankings. We are also going to provide awards for the top three spots in Masters/Open/Junior /Kids divisions. We are preparing to launch a sponsorship and media campaign combining this event and the Canadian National Championships. We will offer 6 slalom clinics locally leading up to the Nationals and a few more leading up to the Worlds hoping to attract more kids and youth into the event. This will add to the dynamics and promotions of both events and the local community.		
Venue description (surface, pitch, length, cone distance, etc). Please describe the hill and course as completely as possible:		
Our venues to this point have a moderate pitch. The racers power, strength and precision will determine the outcome. There are a few possibilities for the Giant Slalom and we will confirm one as soon as we can.		
Venue attractions (local attractions for non-skaters):		
Located in the province of Ontario, Cornwall is an hour South East of Ottawa and one hour west of Montreal. Toronto, Ontario is 4 hours west. We are on the US border and crossing point is Massena, New York. Participants requiring special travel visa arrangements will be helped accordingly. We plan on hosting the racers with a meet and greet on the first of Sept and this followed with 3 days of racing weather permitting. One meal will be provided to the racers each day along with the awards dinner wrap-up party. Details will be posted on.		
Media Coverage:		
We will be doing a complete media blitz as we are anticipating hosting the Worlds. We are in negotiation with local TV and some other media relations people regarding the event and we have history with other slalom events for print media as well. We are expecting some Senior city officials to be present at the Opening ceremonies and during the weekend events.

We are working on several accommodation options for both events.

New ramps are being built for the event. We hope to work out the timing with the Fullbag crew.
