1st Location address	Bush's Pasture Park, 890 Mission St SE, Salem, OR 97302 – Soap Box Derby Hill - a dedicated paved race track inside the park grounds which is closed to motor vehicle traffic. The track is designed for multi-lane soap box derby racing (gravity cars) with a moderate downhill slope (5-7%) and an uphill runout (500 feet/153 meters) with no footbreaking required. Available racing track is 800-1000 feet / 244-305 meters long (not including the runout area) and approx 50 feet / 15 meters wide. Bathroom facilities with flush toilets available top and bottom of the hill; open grass with plentiful tree shade on both sides of the track for spectators. Parking is free and venue access is free too.

Addendum to Worlds 2023 Sanction App

Event Website:

In keeping with our goals to produce a top-level event - organizers have arranged an event website to offer event details, online registration and showcase the registered competitors' profiles – to ensure a professional presentation for the global slalom community, media, sponsors, etc.

The website was created in cooperation with USA Slalom Skateboarding – primarily to showcase the Worlds event - and will be further developed going forward to organize the USA national slalom community, including administering Team USA selection activity for WSG Rome 2024 and future, a directory of regional race organizations, inclusive event calendar and registration portal, general slalom resources and more.

The Road to Rome - Team USA Qualifying Event Status and Result Handling:

This event has been designated as one of three official qualifying events – overall results will be used to pick one man and one woman for Team USA 2024. The other official qualifying events are: US Nationals August 2023 and Texas Sizzler March 2024. Organizers will use a simple overall result calculation to determine the top finishers in each category. All competitors will receive ISSA world ranking points based on the placing values assigned in the ISSA ranking chart protocol.

Course Management Details:

Hybrid Slalom and Tight Slalom - Organizers will set mirrored courses for these head-to-head events. That is – each lane will mirror the other – to help ensure clarity for cone judges and other officials as well as work with the surface conditions/variations between the lanes. Competitors will not be allowed to ride the courses prior to the morning of each event day. All riders will be given equal time to try both lanes during the specified warm-up period.

Giant Slalom – Organizers are pleased to confirm there will be a taller launch ramp option for this single lane event. The ramp will be specially built to suit the conditions and pitch of this venue. Ramp height will be 8' and width will be 4' wide. Transition will be very smooth with a long slope for a fun and exciting launch option. The pitch of this race track is very suitable for head-to-head disciplines but is fairly mellow compared to most optimal giant slalom terrain. Organizers and most racers who have raced at this venue feel adding a bit to the launch factor helps compensate for the lower pitch – and elevates the overall experience to a truer GS status. Use of this special launch ramp by any competitor is optional and not required. A smaller ramp option will be available to choose at will. Organizers will allow extra warm up time so all racers have an opportunity to become familiar with the ramp options before making their decision.
